The Race World Offshore Key West Annual Boat Building Contest and Race in Truman Waterfront Harbor (inside submarine pens).

Open to ages 12-75. Under 18, must have legal guardian present. All participants will have to sign a team registration form and submit it to RWO by October 31st. Entrants are groups/teams of 4 people minimum, 12 people maximum.

1st scored objective: Build a boat in an hour which can hold one team member with the materials and one paddle provided by RWO. One USCG approved life jacket will also be provided by RWO or a sponsor.

2nd scored objective: Win! The boat they make will have to carry that individual in the water from the boat ramp to the RWO race marker in the harbor and back to the starting line. (estimated total of 100' round trip lap) Every participant who goes in the boat shall wear a USCG approved life jacket.

Teams may and are encouraged to bring not more than a total of 6 square feet of paper adhesive backed decals which they can apply to any portion of the boat, above the expected waterline to represent their group or organization.

Points will be awarded as follows:

10	Boat bling, including paper decals	Must be above the waterline
10	Prerace media postings	Requires advanced registration on line

10	Brought most number of people to event	Scored by loud cheering prior to the race
20	1st place in Race	Cross Finish line with person in the boat
15	2nd place in Race	Cross Finish line with person in the boat
10	3rd place in Race	Cross Finish line with person in the boat

- Who are the judges? We will have a wide assortment from powerboat racers, RWO staff, USCG and others.
- Are pets allowed? We are following the rules of the Truman Waterfront Park as dictated by the City of Key West.
