## 7-Mile Offshore Grand Prix Event Requirements



- Sign up for the EZAlerts messaging: Text ezmar23 to 828-499-8660
- All race-entry, team and crew paperwork and payments must be completed online
- Online registrations & payment deadline is April 17th, 2023. Additional charges will apply for late entries.
- Driver & Throttleman must provide a copy of a current medical release to race
  - Attach and email to admin@raceworldoffshore.com
- Riding crew must have a valid dunker and medical certificate. (Dunker will be in Marathon)
- A substitute driver or throttleman for test-day or race day must meet all the same qualifications and be cleared through administration with an arm band.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will be met with swift and appropriate action by RWO.
- All meetings and physicals are mandatory for all classes and for riding crew.
  - Role Call will be the first item on agenda. Driver of record will acknowledge when called, with last name.
- Any emergency request for absence from a mandatory meeting must be cleared in advance with Chief Referee. (Richie Dancisin 732-600-5054)
- Teams will receive an EZ Pass when they arrive at their assigned dry pit area. This EZ Pass shall be quickly completed and returned to an RWO Official at the Tech Trailer to be booked in order of inspections. This is a first come first serve format and we suggest your crew chief complete it and turn it in upon arrival.
- No team shall go to the ramp or crane unless cleared by all tech, safety and administration departments. Race Boat must have an RWO Marathon decal affixed to the portside stern of the raceboat.
- Race day laps & starts may be altered at any time due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Download and bring drivers packet to Saturday 29th, 8:30 am drivers meeting



















## 7-Mile Offshore Grand Prix Race Course






MARATHON RACE COURSE - The RWO Grand Prix race course is a counterclockwise course with a total distance of approximately 5.6 miles. The finish line is adjacent to the 3rd turn and race teams will mill to the north of turn 5 in preparation for race starts.

RESCUE BOAT - Boats identified as rescue boats are staffed with RWO trained divers and medical staff to assist in case of incident.


COURSE MARSHAL BOAT -Two course marshal boats set and manage the race course and manage other on course boats. PACE BOAT- Three boats bring boats from inner basin to milling circle and they are responsible for starting various heats.

TURN / CHECK BOAT - Boats in each turn are a visual landmark for turns, they staff event scorers, and manatee and turtle observers. TOW BOATS - Tow boats assist if a boat becomes disabled or broken down and takes them to safe place on the race course.

PATROL BOAT - These boats manage a specific zone area to ensure spectators do not infringe on the race course.

### 7-Mile Offshore Grand Prix Safety Zones





ZONE MAP - Zone letters designate areas of the race course so all support, safety, team and personnel can quickly identify which particular area of the race course is in question. The mnemonic memory device to the right helps with memorizing the location of zones.

# All Boats Cruise Down To Turn One Even Fairly Good Hardheads Make It Back



Powerboat Racing is a hazardous activity. Individuals must accept that, by engaging in active water sports such as Powerboat Racing, their physical safety may be endangered. Anyone intending to participate in or become involved with Powerboat Racing organized by APBA affiliated clubs either as a participant, team member or otherwise does so at their own risk; and such individuals must recognize the actual and potential risks associated with their involvement, including drowning, hypothermia, and other physical injuries as well as possible death.

Participants acknowledge that it is up to them personally to assess whether any event or activity on the water is too difficult for them or their crew. Individuals acknowledge that the safety of their boat and their entire management, including insurance, is solely their responsibility; and they are satisfied that the boat and the crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race.

Entrants into the event acknowledge that inspection does not constitute a condition survey of the craft and it is solely their responsibility to decide whether or not to start or to continue in any powerboat race. They acknowledge that the efficiency of the helmets and racing vests worn is solely their responsibility. Individuals on signing on to the event agree (on acceptance of their entry upon being permitted to take part in the meeting;

- 1. To be bound by the conditions of the APBA Entry Form, Racing Instructions and the General Competition Rules of the UIM and the APBA.
- 2. To accept the decisions of the organizing committee and officials nominated byit
- 3. To save harmless and keep indemnified:
  - a. The owners of the premises upon which the meeting is held,
  - b. The organizing club, the sponsors and the APBA and their respective officials, servants and agents,
  - c. The other boat owners, drivers, passengers or mechanics engaged in the meeting, AGAINST all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the signatory's property or the property of his/her drivers, passengers and mechanics—whether or not such loss or damage may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said persons or bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Persons under the age of 18 must have written authority signed by either Parent or Guardian.

THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A TEAM'S DECISION TO PARTICIPATE IN A RACE OR TO CONTINUE RACING IS THEIRS ALONE
